- Last 15 years of business career – consultant (director) with PWC/ IBM



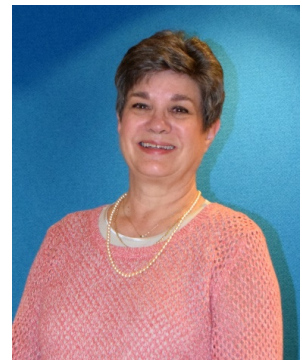
BARBARA BIRDSEYE
