

DOG PARK (FMP) Facilities Master Plan Discussion

Public Meetings: April 23 & May 28, 2025 • 6:30pm

During the March 26, 2025 meeting the ACC Board of Directors had a discussion regarding the three remaining projects on the FMP list.

- Liberty Bell Park Enhancement
- Dog Park Restrooms
- Indoor Multi-Use Courts

During Open Discussion, resident Carol Kaufman made a suggestion in lieu of the Dog Park restrooms, to add benches and shade in the passive area. Following the Board's direction in March, staff have prepared a separate agenda item for the Anthem Dog Park project.

While this multi-step approach may appear lengthy, it serves an important purpose: providing residents multiple opportunities to offer feedback and allowing the Board adequate time to consider and respond to community input.

It is essential to note that all project information presented is conceptual in nature, representing initial ideas rather than final designs. As with previous FMP projects, while the Facilities Master Plan contains the basic concept, the Board maintains full authority to refine the concept, develop the budget, and approve the final design for any project. Included within this document is a map of suggested shade spots along with possible designs.

One idea is to add the same type of trees in the breezeway and boulders for a natural seating/dog play area. Another is to add large shade structures similarly to tennis courts and the community park with benches. Please add your input by going to the resident comment page [linked here](#).


